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Just got the helmet in today and I must say this helmet feels so good compared to my cheaper Pyrotec that is SA2000 rated. Both helmets are large and I weighed them but was a little disappointed that the Sparco weighed in at 3 lbs 11 ozs. with the Hans clips compared to my Pyrotec which weighed in at 3 lbs 9 ozs.

The fit is not even comparable between the two. The Sparco just wraps so softly around my head while the Pyrotec feels like you are wearing something on your head. I think the main reason is the Sparco liner is contoured for your ears so there is no pressure there. Also the cheeks don't seem to be as tight. Overall I am extremely satisfied with my purchase for only \$359 including shipping and no tax.

The only thing that I might be a little concerned about is the small cutout for the viewing area but I guess I won't know until I use it this weekend.
