â□ ¢ Needs vacuum lines at fuel pressure regulator
â□ ¢ Brakes frozen
â□ ¢ Needs front stabilizer bar
â□ ¢ Needs engine mounts
â□ ¢ Pan gasket wet at corners
â□ ¢ Needs bottom left radiator mount
