Many cars pass tech bolting into the OEM mounting locations. On the early cars (pre 85.5), the bolt sizes and floorpan structure are pretty weak. The late cars are better, though both benefit from some further reinforcement. Hanksville Hotrods sells a very nice kit to reinforce this area.
