Since my car didn't have an oil pressure gauge when I got, I'm using an inexpensive little gauge trio from Eggus w/oil pressure, amps and temp. They are mechanical, and the oil pressure runs right off the OEM sender location using a copper line and a couple of fittings to match thread. I'm using the temp gauge for oil, and I had a machine shop drill and tap the extra plug in the oil pan to accommodate the sensor. The amp gauge is running right off the hot wire at the ignition. I got them for about \$40 and so far they have served me well. here's a
