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My 6-point substraps were mounted with the included eyebolts, going through two holes drilled in the floor, with a big piece of steel with two holes for the eyebolts drilled through it under the car for extra backup, and a washer, lockwasher and nut on each one. I can't take a picture of it right now, but it's pretty self-explanatory.

And yeah, you've definitely gotta watch out for the fuel and brake lines when you're drilling in that general area.

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Kevin, on cars where I have fabricated tubular seat mounts, I will weld tabs to the seat mounts.

Otherwise, I like to weld a 1/8" plate to the floor and then either drill and bolt-through the plate, or weld a tab to the plate.

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
